Partnerships

IECF will build relationships with elected officials, policy influencers and community partners .

Advocacy

IECF will develop and and adopt a Policy on Advocacy that frames how we engage in the policy/budget space.

Public Relations

IECF will work with a PR firm to help change the IE narrative in how we engage and bring about systemic change,

Policy Committee
